


CORRECT USE

The Openapi logo will only be used in these circumstances. No rotations, deformations, tilts or distortions are permitted.



CLEAR SPACE ABOUT THE OPENAPI TRADEMARK


The logo usage guidelines are designed to ensure consistent and uniform application in every context. This consistency is essential to increase brand value and improve recognition over time.





SIZING
